Ordinance 1986.7

Dubois County Pipe and Inlet Requirements

1. Persons desiring to bury drainage pipe in the road ditch along their property must first contact the Dubois County Highway Superintendent or County Engineer for a site review.
2. They will make a site review of the proposed location to determine the size and slope of pipe required.
3. Installation of the pipe is to be uniform in alignment and slope with 36" x 36" masonry inlet boxes installed at intervals no greater than 50 feet measured along the pipe. These inlet structures are to be of masonry construction with a concrete bottom, Solid masonry walls and a slotted steel grate top. The top grate is to be a minimum of 8" below the level of the adjacent roadway.
4. A swale is to be constructed directly over the pipe at a minimum depth of 8" below the level of the adjacent roadway and at a slope parallel to the slope of the pipe. The purpose of this swale is to collect the surface runoff water from the roadway and adjacent property and direct it into the inlet grate.
5. Any downspout tiles, basement drains or other surface or ground-water tiles are to enter the pipe at an inlet box.
6. See the attached sheet for drawings of a typical installation.
7. Minimum pipe diameter is 12" and existing conditions must allow a minimum of one foot of backfill on top of the pipe.
8. The landowner is responsible for the proper installation and maintenance of the pipe and inlet structures, keeping them free of silt, debris and functioning properly, for the lifetime of the structures.

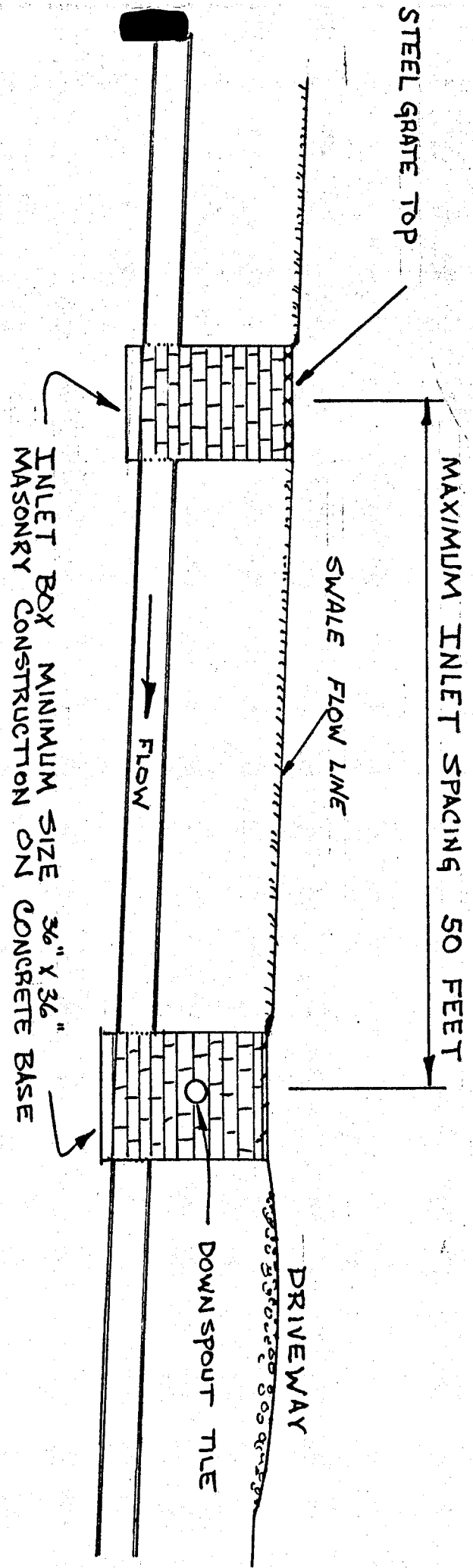
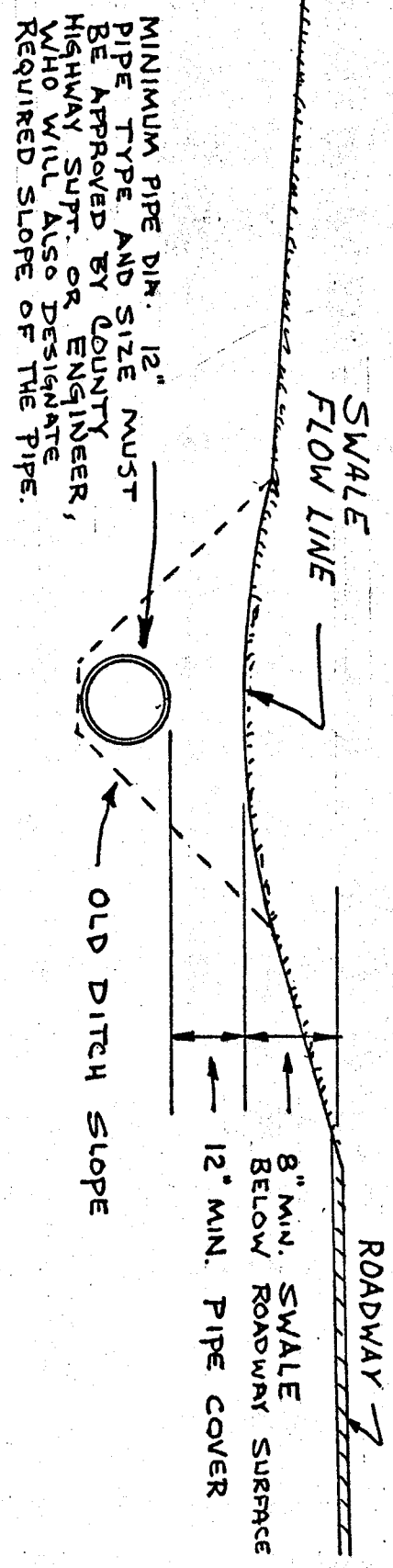

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Dubois County, Indiana, that



SECTION 2. The maximum speed limit on County Road 700S from Huntingburg city limits to 400W is established at Thirty (30) miles per hour.



ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COUNTY SERVICE CHARGE
ON DISHONORED CHECKS

WHEREAS, the Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney has established a procedure for notice, pursuant to I.C. 35-43-5-5 to persons, entities or corporations who have issued or delivered a check, draft, or order on a credit institution for payment of or to acquire money or other property, which check, draft or order has been unpaid or dishonored, and

WHEREAS, such procedure established by the Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney is a governmental service provided to those individuals or businesses which receive such unpaid and dishonored checks, drafts or orders, and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney provides a service not only to such payee or holder of the amount due, but also to the entire citizenry of Dubois County, Indiana, in causing such unpaid and dishonored checks, drafts or orders to be paid by the payor thereof, and

WHEREAS, such payor of the unpaid and dishonored checks, drafts or orders should be required to pay a service charge reasonably related to the cost of the service provided by the Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney, and

WHEREAS, such service charges, when collected by the Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney should be paid over to the County Auditor, as General Fund Miscellaneous Revenue, thereby reimbursing expenses paid, through the budget of the Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney, for salaries, supplies, equipment and other related expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Dubois County, Indiana:

Section 1: The Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney shall impose a service charge, to be paid by the payor of any unpaid and dishonored check, draft or order for which notice is sent pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 35-43-5-5 in an amount not greater than \$ 25.⁰⁰ to cover the cost of such service provided as well as a fee reasonably related to the administrative cost of exercising such regulatory power.

Section 2: The Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney is further directed to impose a service charge or fee, to be paid by the payor of any unpaid and dishonored check, draft or order, in an amount not greater than \$ 50.⁰⁰, in the event that such check, draft or order is not paid within the time period provided by I.C. 35-43-5-5(e) and criminal charges are filed based upon said unpaid check, draft or order resulting in either deferred prosecution, the provisions of a suspended sentence, or the dismissal of the criminal charge wherein one of the conditions of such dismissal is the payment of such service charge.

Section 3: Such service charge or fee to be collected by the Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney shall be in addition to the service fee or charge to be paid to the payee or holder of such check, draft or order as provided by I.C. 35-43-5-5(e).

Section 4: All service charges or fees collected by the Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney, as provided for by the Ordinance, shall be accounted for by the Office of the Dubois County Prosecuting Attorney pursuant to procedures established and approved by the Indiana State Board of Accounts; such service charges and fees shall be remitted on a monthly basis to the Dubois County Auditor to be paid into the General Fund of Dubois County, Indiana, as Miscellaneous Revenue.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication once each week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Dubois County, Indiana.



AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR INSPECTION OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES, SEMI-TRAILER, RECREATIONAL & OTHER VEHICLES BY OFFICERS OF THE DUBOIS COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPT. ESTABLISHING FEES FOR SUCH INSPECTIONS & THE DISPOSITION OF FEES COLLECTED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DUBOIS COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA, THAT:

SEC: 1. THE SHERIFF'S DEPT. IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO MAKE INSPECTIONS OF ALL MOTOR VEHICLES, SEMI-TRAILERS, RECREATIONAL AND OTHER VEHICLES TO ACCOMPANY APPLICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATES OF TITLES FOR SUCH MOTOR VEHICLES, SEMI-TRAILER, RECREATIONAL & OTHER VEHICLES FOR REGISTRATION IN THE STATE OF INDIANA AS REQUIRED BY THE INDIANA BUREAU OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

SEC: 2. THE SHERIFF'S DEPT., AFTER THE NECESSARY INSPECTION HAS BEEN MADE SHALL SIGN THE REQUIRED INSPECTION CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO THE OWNER OF SUCH VEHICLE, IF FOUND NOT TO BE POSSESSED ILLEGALLY; FOR WHICH A REASONABLE FEE OF FIVE (\$5) DOLLARS SHALL BE CHARGED TO THE OWNER. UPON RECEIPT OF SUCH FEE THE SHERIFF OF DUBOIS COUNTY SHALL ISSUE SHERIFF'S RECEIPT NO. 133.
