ORDINANCE NO. 1989-2

Basil C. Hunkel

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING COUNTRY CABLE SYSTEMS, INC., ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, THE NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES AND AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE, MAINTAIN, REPAIR, REPLACE, RENEW, RECONSTRUCT, AND REMOVE A CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM ACROSS PUBLIC PROPERTY IN THE COUNTY LIMITS FOR A TERM OF TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DUBOIS, INDIANA:

1. Grant of franchise. A non-exclusive right is hereby granted to Country Cable Systems, Inc., its successors and assigns to establish, construct, operate, maintain, repair, replace, renew, reconstruct, and remove a cable television system across public property in the county limits for a term of twenty-five (25) years, in accordance with the laws and regulations of the United States of America and the State of Indiana and the Ordinances and regulations of the County of Dubois, including the non-exclusive right, privilege and authority:

- (a) To sell and supply audio, video, data and digital communication services and other electronic services to persons within the County;
- (b) To use public property and right-of-way within the County;
- (c) To engage in such further activities within the County as may now or hereafter be consistent with the generally accepted principles applicable to the operation of a cable television system.

2. Effective Date of Franchise. The franchise shall become effective on the effective date of this Ordinance.

3. Ownership of Franchise. Country Cable Systems, Inc. shall not assign or transfer any right granted under this Ordinance to any other person, company or corporation without prior consent of the Board of Commissioners, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, provided however the company shall have the right to assign or transfer this franchise to a corporation owned by the company or to a limited partnership of which the company, is a partner, general partner or affiliate. No consent by the Board of Commissioners shall be required for a transfer in trust, mortgage, or other financial instrument to secure an indebtedness of the Cable System or Company.

4. Severability Clause. Should any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of record, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereunder other than the part so declared invalid.

5. Conflicting Ordinances. All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, provided, however, that such repeal shall only be to the extent of such conflict.

6. Effective Date of Ordinance. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Board of Commissioners, County of Dubois, Indiana, its publication as provided by law, and its written acceptance by Country Cable Systems, Inc.

7. Insurance. The Company shall maintain in full force and effect, at its own cost and expense, during the term of the Franchise, General Comprehensive Insurance in the amount of \$500,000.00 for bodily injuries (including accidental death) to any one person for each occurrence, and Property Damage Liability Insurance in an amount not less than \$500,000.00 resulting from any one occurrence. The policies shall name Dubois County as an insured. The policies of insurance, or a certified copy of copies thereof, shall be deposited with and kept on file by the Auditor of the County.

ORDINANCE NO. 1980-1

"AN ORDINANCE TO SET RULES AND REGULATIONS ON THE USE OF COUNTY SOLID WASTE CONTAINERS FOR THE COLLECTION OF RUBBISH FOR DISPOSAL BY THE COUNTY IN SANITARY LANDFILLS LOCATED IN THE COUNTY, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DUBOIS COUNTY, INDIANA:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of Dubois County, Indiana, in pursuance to authority granted by the General Assembly of Indiana under I.C. 17-2-22-4 in order to protect the public health and regulate the public disposal of rubbish in sanitary landfills and the gathering of such rubbish hereby declare that the following rules and regulations shall apply to the items that may and may not be deposited in the solid waste containers located in various parts of Dubois County, Indiana.

The term rubbish shall not include bulky items such as refrigerators, washing machines, tables, chairs, sofas, mattresses or other household items, brush and tree trimmings, lumber, table scraps, food, oil and oil products, dead animals or fowl, animal or bird offal, fence wire, fence posts, bricks, stone or dirt, ashes, car or truck tires.

Section 2. That the solid waste containers for disposing of rubbish shall be for the use of residents of Dubois County and shall exclude persons or firms collecting rubbish for a fee, schools, retail, wholesale, manufacturing and other business establishments.

Section 3. That all rubbish shall be placed in the containers provided and not outside the containers.

Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation found violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon being found guilty the violator shall be punished for the first offense by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00); for the second offense by a fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00); and for a third and each subsequent offense by a fine of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) and a sentence of not more than Ninety (90) days.

Section 5. Should any article, section or provision of this Ordinance be declared invalid, by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any portion thereof, other than the portion so declared to be invalid.

Section 6. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 8th day of April, 1980.

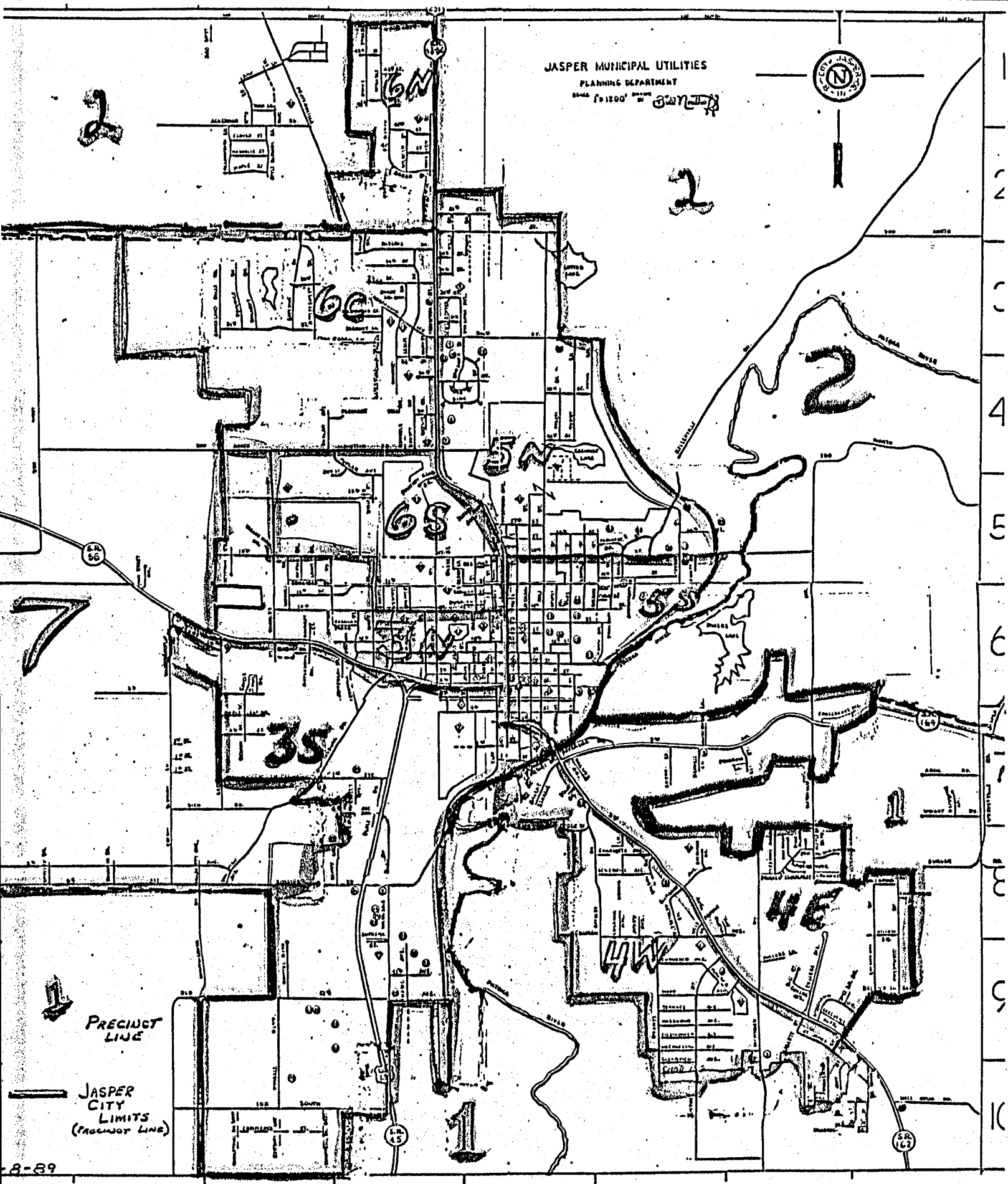
