RESOLUTION

Paul C. Hunkel

WHEREAS, the County of Dubois and the City of Huntingburg have jointly developed a proposed road construction project involving the improvements of existing county roads and the construction of new roads along the western boundary of the City of Huntingburg to provide access to industries in such area creating an industrial access road between State Road 64 West and U.S. Highway 231 North and commonly known as the "Huntingburg Industrial Access Road Project"; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 1988, the Economic Development Administration, U.S. Department of Commerce awarded a grant to the County of Dubois and the City of Huntingburg, jointly, to be applied to the costs of said project, which grant is the lesser of \$725,227.00 or 54.94% of the actual cost of said project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Huntingburg has been awarded a Community Development Block Grant by the Indiana Department of Commerce in the sum of \$334,233.00 for application to the costs of said road project; and

WHEREAS, the County of Dubois and the City of Huntingburg are desirous of designating a lead agency for the administration of such project and providing for the payment of the costs of said project which are not covered by said grants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Dubois County, Indiana that the County of Dubois enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with the City of Huntingburg whereby the County of Dubois agrees to pay 50% of the costs of said Huntingburg Industrial Access Road Project in excess of the amount of the grants aforementioned; provided, however, that the County's share of said project shall not exceed the sum of \$130,000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Huntingburg be designated as the lead agency for the administration of the

"Huntingburg Industrial Access Road Project" and for the administration of all contracts and project funds associated with said project.







TRIAL RECYCLING STATION AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into this 5 day of JUNE, 1989 by and between Jasper Salvage, Inc., River Road, Jasper, Indiana and the Board of Commissioners of Dubois County, Indiana hereinafter referred to as "County".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County desires to establish a recycling station on a trial basis at the County Highway Garage, Jasper, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, a sheltered space will be required for the storage of the recyclable materials such as newspapers, cardboard, glass containers, aluminum cans, and plastic containers.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration for receiving the recyclable materials free of charge, Jasper Salvage, Inc. agrees to:

- (1) furnish a semi-trailer in which the recyclable items can be placed,
- (2) furnish the necessary containers to keep the various recyclable materials separated,
- (3) set up a semi-trailer inside the fenced in area at the County Highway Garage; replacing it when full or as otherwise required.

The County agrees to provide an attendant to keep recyclable items separated.

This agreement shall be for a period of three (3) months from the date of start-up operation.

This agreement may be cancelled by either party by the giving of not less than fourteen (14) days written notice.
